Cats are wonderful pets, but when allowed to roam unsupervised outdoors, can endanger the health and welfare of wildlife. Not only is this unsafe for birds, cats are at risk too. Luckily, there are many simple ways to keep cats and wildlife safe.

- **Indoor Enrichment:** Playing games, chasing lasers, solving food puzzles, or climbing vertical structures (e.g., cat trees) are all great ways to enrich an indoor cat's day.
- **Catios:** It's an enclosed patio for cats – a catio! These fun and customizable enclosures allow your feline friend to safely survey the outdoors, watch birds flutter by, or simply relax in the sun.
- **Leash Training:** It's not just for dogs! Cats, like dogs, can enjoy walking, hiking, and lounging while safely restrained via harness and leash. Or try a stroller!
