There are many simple ways to keep cats and wildlife safe. See American Bird Conservancy's suggestions for a happy, healthy, and safely contained cat!

- **Catios:** These enclosed patios for cats allow your feline friend to safely survey the outdoors, watch birds, or relax in the sun.
- **Leash Training:** It's not just for dogs! Cats, like dogs, can enjoy walking, hiking, and lounging while safely restrained via harness and leash.
- **Strollers:** Cruise the sidewalks in style and comfort with your cat in a stroller. Your cat will enjoy the sights and sounds within a spacious, mobile sanctuary.
- **Indoor Enrichment:** Games, lasers, food puzzles, or vertical structures (e.g., cat trees) are all great ways to enrich an indoor cat's day.
