



A Win For Birds in Maryland

In April, Lawmakers passed the Maryland Sustainable Buildings Act (HB6), which mandates all newly built, acquired, or renovated state-owned buildings use state funds to install bird-friendly windows and lighting. HB6's passage was a long time in the making — American Bird Conservancy (ABC) has been advocating for the bill for the past six years. The Act is a valuable win for birds and builds momentum for other places to pass similar legislation.
