



Gray-breasted Parakeets Fly Free at Reintroduction Site

Gray-breasted Parakeets, found only in Brazil, were on the brink of extinction when conservationists stepped in to save the species just over a decade ago. Now, the species is doing so well in its last stronghold in the Baturité Mountains that conservationists have hatched an ambitious plan to reintroduce it across its historic range. With support from ABC, the first phase of that plan hit an incredible milestone earlier this year, when a group of Gray-breasted Parakeets released at a reintroduction site with ideal habitat successfully raised chicks.
