

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Dear Partners and Supporters:

What a great year we had in 2022! While we are still closing the financial books as of this writing, 2022 is poised to go down as American Bird Conservancy's biggest and best fundraising year yet — which means more resources to deliver bird habitat results across the Americas. I hope you'll take a few minutes to read about the successes your support and collaboration made possible.

I'm particularly excited about our progress in Hawai'i, where the window of opportunity to save native forest birds is rapidly closing. The driver of this urgency is non-native mosquitoes that carry avian malaria, a fatal disease. Climate change is enabling the insects to reach the last high-elevation refuges of Hawaiian honeycreepers such as the 'I'iwi (shown below). The Birds, Not Mosquitoes program — a project of ABC and several key partners — will soon begin ground-truthing a new technique to suppress mosquito populations, making bird habitat safer and staving off extinctions. Please see birdsnotmosquitoes.org for more information, and stay tuned to learn about results.

Another important 2022 result was the expansion of Brazil's Serra Bonita Reserve, home to the Critically Endangered

Banded Cotinga and Endangered Boa Nova Tapaculo. ABC plays a critical role when it comes to ensuring a future for birds like these — species that are surviving on the edge of extinction and which would likely disappear forever without our intervention to keep their habitats intact.

One final highlight: We welcomed our first Conservation and Justice Fellows to ABC in 2022! These eight individuals brought diverse perspectives and experiences to ABC, expanding our thinking, helping to ensure the sustainability of our projects, and enriching our organization in countless ways. Thank you to our Fellows, to our loyal and growing community of ABC members and supporters, and to everyone who contributed to ABC's success in 2022. Here's to conserving even more habitat in 2023!


PREVENTING BIRD EXTINCTIONS



The most endangered birds often survive in tiny pockets of habitat, and every acre matters. To prevent extinctions in Latin America and the Caribbean in 2022, ABC helped protect more than 7,000 acres of habitat in new and expanded protected areas, and supported community conservation agreements for almost 36,000 additional acres. Our overall results — 1.2 million acres of habitat protected — benefit people, too, by conserving water; sequestering carbon to help combat climate change; and more.

Highlights:

- ◆ The Critically Endangered **Antioquia Brushfinch**, once thought extinct, got its own protected area in 2022: The 880-acre Montañerito Paisa Reserve, established with local partner SalvaMontes and support from Rainforest Trust and Conserva Aves. The Conserva Aves partnership — comprising ABC, BirdLife International, National Audubon Society, and RedLAC — aims to protect or strengthen 100 or more “territories of life” in nine Latin American countries. ABC and Conserva Aves also helped to expand the Buenaventura Reserve in the Ecuadorian Andes in 2022, working with local partner Fundación de Conservación Jocotoco to protect 550 acres of cloud forest for the Endangered **El Oro Parakeet**.
- ◆ In Peru’s Sangal Valley, we worked with our partner Asociación Ecosistemas Andinos (ECOAN) to create the first protected area for the Critically Endangered **Gray-bellied Comet**, and supported ECOAN’s efforts to grow and plant native species that provide food and nesting habitat for the comet. In neighboring Bolivia, we continued efforts with Fundación Natura Bolivia for the Critically Endangered **Red-fronted Macaw**, supporting conservation agreements with local communities to protect 35,975 acres of foraging habitat within the Pasorapa Integrated Management Natural Area.
- ◆ In Brazil, we enabled Instituto Uiraçu to protect 661 acres of protected habitat in the Serra Bonita Reserve for the Critically Endangered **Banded Cotinga**. And we supported our local partner Aquasis’ efforts to establish a new breeding population of the Endangered **Gray-breasted Parakeet**. Several birds translocated to the new site have now successfully raised young.
- ◆ The Search for Lost Birds — a partnership of ABC, Re:wild, and BirdLife International — had great success in 2022, setting the stage for urgent conservation measures. In Colombia, ABC supported fieldwork on the **Santa Marta Sabrewing**, an endemic hummingbird that was rediscovered in July after going unseen for more than 10 years. ABC-funded follow-up surveys recorded additional observations. On the other side of the world, ABC co- led an expedition in Papua New Guinea that located the **Black-naped Pheasant-Pigeon** — a species last documented by scientists in 1882.
- ◆ We reached a milestone in our work with partners to create a safe nesting colony of **‘Ua‘u (Hawaiian Petrel)** at Nihoku, Kaua‘i: In November 2022, the first chick of previously translocated birds left its nest burrow and flew off to sea. The chick’s parents and other Hawaiian Petrels, as well as Critically Endangered **‘A‘o (Newell’s Shearwaters)**, had been translocated to the fenced, predator-free site at Nihoku as nestlings; after fledging and spending several years at sea, increasing numbers of birds have been returning to breed. The long-awaited fledgling raises hopes for more success in the future.
- ◆ Other endangered birds benefited from ABC’s support of habitat protection, including the **Orange-bellied Antwren** (Brazil), **Blue-billed Curassow** (Colombia), and **Black-breasted Puffleg** (Ecuador).





STAFF HIGHLIGHT

Eliana Fierro-Calderón, International Conservation Project Officer

Growing up in Cali, Colombia, Eliana spent a lot of time fishing and hiking with her family. Birds became her focus while she was pursuing her Biology degree at the Universidad del Valle. "About half-way through my undergraduate degree," she says, "I took the ornithology class because I'd heard the professor was really good. The short story is: I took that class and I never left it ... I fell in love with birds."

After receiving her degree, with a specialization in Zoology, Eliana worked for 11 years at the Cali-based conservation organization Asociación Calidris. While there, she received a Master's in Geographic Information Systems from Universidad de San Francisco de Quito in Ecuador and transitioned from Research Assistant to Coordinator of the Focal Species Initiative, leading a group monitoring Colombia's threatened and endemic bird species.

During gaps in work contracts, Eliana studied birds in Arizona and then in Borneo, where she met her future husband. A few years later, the couple moved to the United States, where Eliana was soon hired by ABC. "I'm really happy at ABC," she says. "When I moved to the U.S., I thought I might not be able to work in Colombia anymore. But now I work in conservation, in the tropics, on my own country," she says. As an ABC International Conservation Project Officer, Eliana focuses on bird conservation work with partners in Colombia and Venezuela. She also supports projects in the Search for Lost Birds program.

Eliana smiles when she thinks back to the spark ignited by that college ornithology course. An earlier class had drawn her to start studying spiders. "That was just a two-year love," she recalls, "before birds came into my life."

REVERSING BIRD POPULATION DECLINES



Healthy habitat: It's the centerpiece of our work to reverse birds' stunning population declines. In priority areas, including vital places called BirdScapes, ABC works across vast landscapes to ensure that rapidly declining species have the habitats they need, from breeding grounds to wintering grounds and stopovers in between. In 2022, working with partners — federal and state entities; regional and local nonprofits; and hundreds of private landowners — we improved more than 250,000 acres of bird habitat.

Highlights in the United States:

Much of our habitat work in the United States is accomplished through the Migratory Bird Habitat Joint Ventures (JVs) — regional partnerships that bring federal and state entities together with private landowners and non-governmental organizations to get bird conservation done on the ground. ABC staff lead and work within several of these JVs. We're grateful to our partners in the JVs for their incredible collaboration for birds across the U.S. and into Mexico!

Grasslands: Since 1970, populations of grassland birds have been reduced by more than half, reflecting a loss of more than 720 million birds. ABC is helping to reverse the trend by working with our regional JV partners and private landowners to achieve more grassland conservation for birds. Together, in 2022, we enhanced management on more than 100,000 grassland acres from North Dakota (Northern Great Plains BirdScape) to Mexico (Valles Centrales BirdScape), using safely applied prescribed fire and grazing to mimic natural ecosystem processes. By promoting best management practices on private working lands, where most of these habitats occur, we improved the prospects for declining birds from the **Chestnut-collared Longspur** and **Sprague's Pipit** to the **Eastern Meadowlark** and **Henslow's Sparrow**.

- ◆ In ABC's Southwest region, the ABC-led Rio Grande Joint Venture (RGJV), via a National Fish and Wildlife Foundation grant, improved management on 834 acres of grasslands and provided 130 land managers with

information about sustainable grassland management for **Northern Bobwhite** quail, other priority bird species, and Endangered Monarch butterflies. Another project, focused on brush management, improved grassland bird habitat on nearly 1,200 acres in Brewster County, Texas.

- ◆ ABC staff with the RGJV also developed water management strategies to support bird habitat, which were ultimately approved by the Upper Rio Grande Regional Flood Planning Group. Water management is becoming an increasingly critical issue due to scarcity of this precious resource.
- ◆ The Oaks and Prairies JV enhanced more than 2,500 acres of grasslands in Oklahoma by using prescribed burns. The Oklahoma Chapter of The Nature Conservancy recognized ABC's Ken Gee and Cole Fagen as Conservation Champions for their efforts to support safe use of fire for management in the state.

- ◆ Also in Texas, ABC conducted its second year of Grassland Effectiveness Monitoring (GEM), measuring habitat changes at project sites and gaining support for standardized restoration methodologies. In the Southern Great Plains, staff introduced a decision-support tool called "Tree-age" using geospatial and bird population data to model management effects on bird populations. All of these efforts are helping to get successful grassland restoration done on the ground.

STAFF HIGHLIGHT

Jesús Franco, Assistant Coordinator for the Rio Grande Joint Venture

Back in middle school in Durango, Mexico, Jesús knew he wanted to pursue a "woody" livelihood. "Then a group of teachers visited us from a technical high school where you could get an Associate's degree in Forestry," he remembers. "The prospect of being able to make a living working in the great outdoors really resonated with me." Jesús earned the Associate's degree, followed by a Bachelor's degree in Forestry Engineering from Antonio Narro Agrarian Autonomous University.

After earning a Master's in Range and Wildlife Management from Texas A&M University-Kingsville, he became a Research Associate, focused on Loblolly Pine forest productivity, at Louisiana State University.

Then at the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department, Jesús worked first as an urban wildlife biologist; he later worked in positions involving cross-border collaboration on wildlife management and population monitoring.

He recently celebrated his tenth anniversary, and Jesús says he appreciates working at ABC. "In my current position on the binational Rio Grande Joint Venture, I help to advance national and international bird conservation initiatives in the U.S. and Mexico," he says. "I work both in my native country and my adoptive country, to apply my expertise in both places. To me, that is huge and deeply rewarding." His work involves building partnerships and facilitating conservation projects, from planning and implementation to evaluation.

Jesús feels ABC always watches out for its staff. "As a person of color, as a minority, and as an immigrant to this country, it is very important to me that ABC has the vision and the focus to be inclusive and diverse," he says. "ABC has been great to us, especially in the pandemic, supporting us to make sure everyone was okay, that resources were available to staff. To me, that says a lot about the organization: It's not just a place to work, it's much more than that."

Forests, riparian and coastal areas, and wetlands: In 2022, we worked with JVs and other partners to restore and enhance more than 150,000 acres in forests and other habitats — from Oregon to Southern California, New York to Mississippi, and places in between. These efforts aim to reverse declines of an array of bird species ranging from the **Southwestern Willow Flycatcher** and **Marbled Murrelet** to the **Cerulean Warbler** by boosting the health of bird habitat where it is needed most.

- ◆ A few examples of habitat restoration: Partners with the Central Hardwoods JV — one of several JVs staffed and supported by ABC — accomplished more than 132,000 acres of habitat restoration for birds such as the **Prairie Warbler** in 2022. In the Great Lakes region, ABC staff enhanced nearly 7,000 acres for species that require young-forest conditions, including the **Golden-winged Warbler** and **American Woodcock**. And the Lower Mississippi Valley JV partnership restored 22,337 acres of open pine forest on private lands in Arkansas, Louisiana, and Texas, providing habitat for birds such as the **Red-headed Woodpecker** and **Northern Bobwhite**.
- ◆ In the Southeast, ABC continued work with forestry partners, including International Paper, to implement bird-friendly practices across thousands of acres of working forests, benefiting the **Swallow-tailed Kite**.
- ◆ Our Northwest region led the rollout of the “Crumb Clean Campaign” in partnership with the Siuslaw National Forest in Oregon and Environment for the Americas. The campaign promotes removing food waste from campsites and recreation areas to prevent attracting opportunistic predators such as Common Ravens, which also raid nearby **Marbled Murrelet** and **Western Snowy Plover** nests.
- ◆ On the Texas Gulf Coast, we protected seven sites for beach-nesting birds, including **Snowy** and **Wilson’s Plovers** and **Least Terns**. At the end of April, **Snowy Plovers** nested on East Beach in Galveston — an ABC project

site — for the first time since 2018, and hatched a chick! Our signs and fencing, maintained by ABC and partners, help people and birds share the beach.

- ◆ In the Atlantic Coast JV, ABC worked with Alligator River National Wildlife Refuge in North Carolina to test an impoundment intended to support the rapidly disappearing **Black Rail**. After managing and monitoring water levels and vegetation, more than 50 acres of promising habitat resulted. **Sora** were detected following the improvements, and **Black Rail** surveys will be conducted in 2023.

Highlights in Latin America and the Caribbean:

- ◆ ABC is working to help communities earn income from forested areas — helping to prevent land-clearing for cattle and other land uses detrimental to birds. For example, we’re supporting farmers’ efforts to grow cacao under the shade of trees in Honduras’ Moskitia region, home to wintering **Golden-winged Warblers** and **Ruby-throated Hummingbirds**. ABC helped connect our local partner Cacao Miskito (a community-run cacao company) with Uncommon Cacao, a company buying sustainably sourced cacao from around the world; now, multiple chocolatiers globally are using Moskitia cacao from Honduras.
- ◆ Also in Honduras, in the Pico Bonito-Yoro BirdScape, ABC supported our partner ASIDE’s efforts to reforest almost 54 acres in the La Muralla Wildlife Refuge, with 23,000 native pines planted. The work will help to restore the mixed pine-oak forest habitat for migratory birds such as the **Canada** and **Blue-winged Warbler**.
- ◆ In the Dominican Republic’s Septentrional BirdScape — home to wintering **Bicknell’s Thrushes** — ABC supported development of the world’s first Bird Friendly cacao production and management standards by the Smithsonian Migratory Bird Center and company Zorzal Cacao. The standards describe the features that cacao farms must have to earn the Bird Friendly certification. To





date, the 171 participating farms have produced more than 160 tons of Bird Friendly cacao.

- ◆ Grasslands in northern Mexico are vital to migratory birds such as the **Baird's Sparrow** and resident birds including the Endangered **Worthen's Sparrow**. In the El Tokio BirdScape, ABC provided support to Pronatura Noreste for invasive plant removal on 70 acres of grassland bird habitat, helping to enhance natural grassland regeneration.
- ◆ In Guatemala's Conservation Coast BirdScape, ABC helped our partner FUNDAECO acquire 2,855 acres in the Cerro San Gil Protected Area, ensuring winter habitat for migratory birds such as the **Golden-winged Warbler** and **Wood Thrush**. Our shade cardamom impact investing pilot project in Guatemala turned profits for the first time, which were reinvested into the project and supported restoration of 16 acres of shade cardamom lost due to hurricanes. Thousands of native trees and cardamom plants were planted, benefiting the **Worm-eating Warbler** and other birds.
- ◆ In the Northern Venezuela Coastal Mountains BirdScape, with ABC support, our partner Provita planted 8,925 coffee and native trees as part of its

Birds and Coffee initiative. More than 30 producers have had their coffee certified as Bird Friendly by the Smithsonian Migratory Bird Center, helping them to earn higher profits and provide habitat for birds including wintering **Olive-sided Flycatchers**.

Highlights on Migratory Bird Tracking:

- ◆ We took steps in 2022 to improve the data we have about migratory birds, so that we can take the most effective actions to reverse their declines. ABC's Northwest region — working in partnership with Birds Canada — provided leadership for the expansion of the Motus Wildlife Tracking System, a network of stations that collects signals from small, digitally coded tags affixed to migratory birds across the Americas.
- ◆ ABC's Northern Great Plains program facilitated construction of six Motus towers in 2022 to support tracking of grassland birds such as the **Baird's Sparrow**. ABC is also tracking **Black Terns**, **Oregon Vesper Sparrows**, **Long-billed Curlews**, and **Eastern** and **Western Meadowlarks** using tiny transmitters attached to the birds prior to their migration from the northern U.S. and Canada to their southern wintering grounds.

REDUCING THREATS TO ALL BIRDS



ABC works to reduce the impacts of human-caused dangers in bird habitats. These include glass windows and night-time lighting; poorly sited energy development; non-native predators such as free-roaming cats; and much more. In 2022, this work took place in bird habitats from Hawai'i and Wisconsin to Brazil and South Korea, in partnership with organizations from Yale University to Amazon.com, Inc.

Highlights:

- ◆ In 2022, we welcomed new partners in the effort to reduce bird-glass collisions. ABC began work with Yale — helping the university implement bird-friendly building design and retrofit existing structures — while at Cornell University, ABC is consulting on a bird-friendly design policy and monitoring program. ABC is also helping to identify bird-friendly glass for the Amazon Helix building, centerpiece of the company's new Arlington, Virginia campus.
- ◆ ABC and partners submitted an *amicus curiae* brief that influenced the trial court's decision to uphold Madison, Wisconsin's bird-friendly design ordinance, bringing the number of states and municipalities with bird-friendly building guidelines to more than 22 — with more pending. To facilitate getting more bird-friendly glass into the marketplace, ABC's two glass-testing tunnels evaluated 60 samples from 19 manufacturers in 2022, including products from the U.S., Brazil, China, Germany, and South Korea. Forty of these samples met our criteria for "bird friendly."
- ◆ In 2022, ABC and partners on Kaua'i helped to reduce the impact of free-roaming cats, including by supporting the introduction and passage of legislation prohibiting cat abandonment and cat-feeding on county properties. In addition, through a partnership of ABC and the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, 63 feral cats were removed from national wildlife refuges on Kaua'i, home to the Endangered 'Ae'o (Hawaiian Black-necked Stilt) and **Koloa Maoli** (Hawaiian Duck). ABC also helped to defeat state legislation in Hawai'i, Kansas, Virginia, and West Virginia that would have resulted in more cats on the landscape.
- ◆ Since its 2020 launch by ABC and partners including Gulf Coast Bird Observatory, the SPLASH (Stopping Plastics and Litter Along Shorelines) program has removed over 30,000 pounds of trash that put birds such as **Snowy Plovers** and **Black Skimmers** at risk. More than 10,000 students and community members have now worked with SPLASH — including Texas A&M University's 2022 Sea Camp, which engaged students in finding solutions to marine debris, in addition to picking up litter.
- ◆ ABC supports and advocates for renewable energy — and also speaks out when projects are sited in places that pose unacceptably high risks to birds. In 2022, ABC continued to fight the Rocky Forge Wind project in Virginia, which would put **Golden Eagles** at risk. In Brazil, ABC continued as a leading voice advocating for the Voltalia wind energy project to be moved out of the Endangered **Lear's Macaw's** range.
- ◆ Hope for native Hawaiian forest birds continued to grow in 2022 as the Birds, Not Mosquitoes initiative gained steam toward a 2023 test launch. It's anticipated that this large-scale effort by ABC and partners will help to curb non-native mosquitoes, which transmit deadly avian malaria to birds such as the Critically Endangered 'Akohekohe, 'Akeke'e, and **Kiwikiu**, as well as the 'Anianiau — smallest of the Hawaiian honeycreepers. Climate change is enabling the disease-carrying mosquitoes to reach the last high-elevation refuges of native Hawaiian birds.





STAFF HIGHLIGHT

E. Hardy Kern, Director of Government Relations, Pesticides and Birds Campaign

When he was four or five years old, a pivotal encounter set the stage for Hardy's career: "At day camp at the Pittsburgh Zoo," he says, "we had the chance to feed a giraffe. When I took the biscuit and held it out, this huge head came careening down and gently took the food from my hand. I knew then that wildlife would be at the center of my life."

Hardy says he grew up at the Pittsburgh Zoo, moving from day camper and volunteer into an education department position.

Concerns about pollution and habitat loss drew him into politics at a young age. When he was 16 years old, Hardy won a seat on the Peters Township Environmental Quality Board. (He was the youngest person ever to serve there.) That same year, he hosted the first episode of "Conservation Nation with Hardy Kern" on Peters Township Community TV. The program ran for 14 episodes over two years.

After earning a Zoology degree from Ohio State University, Hardy worked ten years at the Columbus Zoo as a zookeeper. Seeing political action as his next frontier, he earned a Master's in Public Administration, with a focus on policy and nonprofit governance, from Kent State University.

Today, Hardy lobbies for policies that embrace bird conservation and confronts dangers pesticides pose to birds and their habitats. "I'm always working to find ways to present important issues in a way that's palatable and actionable, so people can do something to fix it."

Hardy feels he's found a perfect perch at ABC. "Two of my favorite things have been birds and politics," he notes, "and now I have my dream job — bird politics. That's hard to beat."

BUILDING THE BIRD CONSERVATION MOVEMENT



To enhance results for birds, ABC works to build a vibrant bird conservation community throughout the Americas. These efforts provide a diverse array of partners with expertise and tools — and they in turn help us ensure that our work is equitable and sustainable. “Building the movement” includes providing learning opportunities and financial assistance to partner organizations; supplying government leaders with recommendations on conserving priority species; helping communities create habitats that support birds and welcome people; and more.

Highlights:

- ♦ One of ABC’s intrinsic beliefs is that bird conservation can only be truly sustainable when it is ethical and inclusive. In 2022, we launched our Conservation and Justice Fellowship program to advance conservation approaches that benefit both birds and people. Our inaugural cohort of eight Fellows is working with ABC staff and partners across the Americas, focusing on topics ranging from understanding the impact of pesticides on birds and migrant farmworkers, to promoting Indigenous grassland stewardship. Their discoveries will help inform ABC’s conservation efforts and bird conservation more broadly. We thank the 2022 cohort of ABC Fellows for their collaboration: Katia Pilar Carranza, Noah Gomes, Barbara Kipreos, Javier A. Román Nieves, Ellen Sanders-Raigosa, Claudia Santiago, Swapna Shepherd, and Harrison Watson.
 - ♦ We continue to help our partners in Latin America and the Caribbean conserve priority bird species, thanks to the Latin American Reserve Stewardship Initiative (LARSi). Through this cooperative program of ABC and the March Conservation Fund, LARSi supported ten organizations in six countries in 2022. Among other projects, LARSi enabled staff from two Brazilian partners — Instituto Araguaia and SAVE Brazil — to visit ABC-supported reserves in Peru and Ecuador, where they learned techniques that will help them to conserve the **Kaempfer’s Woodpecker**, **Blue-eyed Ground-Dove**, and other Brazilian wildlife. Over its eight-year history, LARSi has funded capacity-building efforts for 23 partners, awarding a total of \$2.6 million.
- ♦ The Bird City Network — led by ABC and Environment for the Americas — welcomed the Bird City Mexico program in 2022, with Isla Cozumel meeting the requirements to become its first Bird City community in October. This is the first of many new Bird Cities to come, as the network has officially launched and is conducting outreach to encourage bird conservation actions by communities via its website birdcity.org.
- ♦ The seabird colony at Fort Wool in Virginia had another great year in 2022: Thousands of seabirds, displaced by construction in Hampton Roads in 2020, returned to breed for a third year. Five state-threatened species, including **Royal** and **Sandwich Terns**, now breed at Fort Wool. ABC is proud to have worked with the Virginia Department of Wildlife Resources to help launch this successful project.
- ♦ ABC is leading an effort with the North American Bird Conservation Initiative (NABCI) to expand the involvement of nontraditional actors in bird conservation. A demonstration project in Ecuador brought together the Chachi Indigenous community and a local nonprofit to establish a new agroforestry business model for cacao — one that generates profits while also scaling up bird conservation.

STAFF HIGHLIGHT

Melissa Ludwig, Grants Officer

Melissa dove headfirst into birding and photography shortly after starting at ABC three years ago. It began with an ABC webinar on how to take better bird photos. "I remember thinking: I want to do that ... right now!" she says. "I wasn't that outdoorsy as a kid," she recalls, but today, Melissa spends much of her free time in the field. She recently tallied her 500th species, the Bobolink.

Although birding is relatively new to Melissa, she's had a lifelong affinity for feathered creatures. "When I was growing up, we had pet birds at home, plus my father worked in the Birds division of the Smithsonian's National Museum of Natural History," she notes.

"My journey's been a bit of a winding road," Melissa says. She majored in Music at James Madison University in Virginia, then taught English for a year in South Korea. After returning to her hometown of Rockville,

Maryland, she worked at the International School of Music in Bethesda, Maryland, and Casey Trees and Urban Land Institute in Washington, D.C.

Melissa feels she's found a great fit with ABC. "It all comes back to the mission," she explains. "I love that I get to work at a place where my job directly leads to results for birds." She works closely with program staff to apply for new federal and state grants that support regional programs and Migratory Bird Habitat Joint Ventures, then helps ensure that spending occurs at the right pace and with promised deliverables.

"Working with a group of people who are so focused on birds like me is really awesome," Melissa says. "I feel very lucky that the stars aligned, and that I was able to join the ABC flock."





FOCUS ON BIRD HABITAT

In 2022, ABC took measurable steps to ensure that birds have the places they need to thrive:

- We supported improvements on more than 250,000 acres in grasslands, forests, and other bird habitats across the United States;
- To prevent extinctions in Latin America and the Caribbean in 2022, we helped protect more than 7,000 acres of habitat in new and expanded protected areas, and supported community conservation agreements for almost 36,000 additional acres.
- With our partners, we planted more than 485,000 trees and shrubs, improving habitat and combating climate change; and
- We made strides to make habitats safer for birds — reducing threats from invasive species, window collisions, and more.




